Strategic Plan

The next major step in the development of a strategic plan takes place later this month. Nearly 80 representatives of Quincy's schools and parishes, including pastors and principals, will join for a two-day, goal setting retreat. At the end of these two days, a strategic plan to guide Quincy's four Catholic elementary schools for the next three years should be approximately 80% complete. The plan will establish strategic goals in the following domains:

- Catholic Identity
- Academics
- Finance
- Facilities
- Student Life
- Enrollment and Marketing
- Advancement

Individuals from across the four parishes and schools were asked to participate on a specific domain committee. The selection process for the participants was conducted with the intention of gathering a variety of voices from the community. Pastors, principals, and Provisional Advisory Board members recommended participants based on their knowledge of subject matter, their relationship to the parishes and/or schools, and their willingness to actively participate in this time-intensive project. Every effort was made to secure equal representation of the parishes and schools to ensure the plan remains focused on the strategic vision for all of the schools.

As part of this process, participants were asked to review a comprehensive report which provided the current status of each of these domain areas across the four schools. They have also been tasked with completing multiple surveys about this report to help identify areas of focus in each domain for the retreat.
