



Quincy Catholic Schools Board Update

Throughout the course of the past few months, the Corporate Board (comprised of the four pastors and a representative of the Bishop) and the provisional advisory Board of Specified Jurisdiction (BSJ) largely focused on two priority areas - the hiring of a Chief Administrative Leader and the strategic plan.

Chief Administrative Leader: The job posting for the Chief Administrative Leader (CAL) was finalized and posted locally, regionally, and nationally in May. A search committee comprised of members of the BSJ representing each of the four participating parishes was formed. The candidates interviewed with the search committee and all five Catholic school principals. Dr. Christopher Gill was recommended by the search committee and then selected by the Corporate Board with support from Bishop Paprocki. He began on October 2.

Since 2021, Dr. Gill served as the Vice President of Student Affairs and Dean of Students for Notre Dame College in South Euclid, Ohio. Prior to that, he was the Dean of Student Life at Culver-Stockton College.

Strategic Plan: One of the first orders of business for the provisional advisory Board of Specified Jurisdiction is to develop a five-year strategic plan. Thanks to the generous support of the Tracy Family Foundation, the board has hired Partners in Mission (PIM) to facilitate this important endeavor.

The creation of the plan is a multi-layered process which will require a significant amount of participation and input from the community at large. The plan will focus on eight domain areas.

- Catholic Identity
- Academics
- Advancement and Communications
- Enrollment and Marketing
- Facilities
- Finance and Human Resources
- Governance
- Student Life

Members of the BSJ will serve as chairs for each of these domains. They will seek community members to fill additional roles such as domain co-chairs and domain committee members.
