Fr. Augustus Tolton Scholarship: Applicant Eligibility Criteria

The Fr. Augustus Tolton Scholarship provides full tuition for K-8 students to one family from each of Quincy's four Catholic parishes (Blessed Sacrament, St. Anthony, St. Francis, and St. Peter) based on financial need determined by the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Application. The recipients remain confidential.

Eligibility and Continuation

- Families must demonstrate financial need annually and comply with all eligibility requirements.
- Scholarships extend until the last child in the family completes 8th grade, provided enrollment is continuous, there is demonstrated financial need, and funding remains available.
- Upon completion, the scholarship is awarded to a new family from the same parish following the same criteria.

Application Process

- Submit the Fr. Augustus Tolton Scholarship Form by **5 p.m. on April 4, 2025**, via mail or email to Sara Reuschel, Executive Director, QCES Foundation.
- Complete the online FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment, submit required documentation, and pay the \$40 processing fee by **11:59 p.m. on April 4, 2025**.
- Annually submit the Parish Pastor's Verification Form, signed by the parish pastor, confirming:
 - Baptism of the child(ren) in the Catholic Church.
 - Active family participation in the Catholic faith, including weekly Mass attendance and parish involvement.

Additional Details

- Scholarships cover tuition only; families are responsible for other fees, including the Resource Fee. Failure to pay required fees will result in disqualification.
- Other tuition assistance, such as the Gene Grawe Fund, is applied first, with the scholarship covering the remaining balance.
- If no qualifying applicant exists for a specific parish, the scholarship may be awarded to a family from another parish based on financial need.

Withdrawal and Reevaluation

- If a family withdraws or fails to meet eligibility, the scholarship may be reallocated to another qualifying family from the same parish.
- The QCES Foundation Board reserves the right to modify scholarship criteria as needed.

Notification of Scholarship Award

- Recipients will be notified via email. Recipients must confirm acceptance of the scholarship before it is applied to their account.

- Complete and submit the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Application Form, along with supporting documentation (W2s, 2020 tax return, etc.), and the required processing fee by 11:59 p.m. on April 4, 2025.
