November Leadership Team Meeting

The Quincy Catholic Schools Leadership Team met on Monday, November 8, 2022. During this meeting, the team reviewed the draft of the by-laws prepared by Mr. Jim Bock, Chancellor and General Counsel for the Diocese of Springfield. Mr. Bock joined the team via video conference and was able to answer questions, provide clarification, and discuss next steps.

- Step 1: Mr. Bock will share the draft of the by-laws with Bishop Paprocki for his review.
- Step 2: The Corporate Board members will identify and present a proposed roster for the Board of Specified Jurisdiction to Bishop Paprocki. (more information below)

Once these items are shared with Bishop Paprocki, the team's request will be to approve the by-laws in order for the Board of Specified Jurisdiction to be formed.

Board of Specified Jurisdiction

Per the draft of the by-laws, the Board of Specified Jurisdiction will

- consist of a minimum of nine members;
- represent each of the four Participating Parishes (Blessed Sacrament, St. Anthony, St. Francis, and St. Peter);
- include a representative from Quincy Notre Dame High School and the Quincy Catholic Elementary Schools Foundation;
- be selected and appointed by the Corporate Board of Directors which is comprised of the four pastors and the Diocesan Superintendent of Catholic Schools;
- be a practicing Catholic in good standing; and
- serve a three year term.
